

Central High School Alumni Building Use & Guidelines

The Central High School Alumni Building has been made available to Central Alumni Association by the Metropolitan Government of Nashville for our use to hold gatherings and various functions including but not limited to open houses, alumni and class parties, committee meetings, other gatherings of alumni and to store Central High School Memorabilia. The building is the property of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville.

The following guidelines should be observed

- 1) No smoking or alcoholic beverages on the premises - by order Metropolitan Government
- 2) Please clean your mess up. Cleaning materials and utensils can be found the cabinets next to the stove. All dishes, utensils and other items are to be place back in the location where they were found. Trash and recycle containers are located through out the building and upon leaving all trash should be placed in the dumpster by the entrance gate
- 3) No animals/pets are allowed

Reservations will be taken on a first come first serve bases and a Central High Alumni must attend the gathering or function. The current year 50th Anniversary Class will have a standing reservation for the building on the evening prior to the banquet provided that a confirmation is received from this class prior to January 1st of the year of the banquet. Each class will be given free use of the building for one party per year and for class party planning meetings

The cost of reserving the building for all other functions is \$30.00 if your class has purchased 17 or more nameplates or \$60 if your class has purchased less that 17 nameplates. In addition to the use of the building, a nameplate (\$30) or two nameplates (\$60) will be issued for a deceased class member(s) or anyone the class chooses for your class or another class.
